

# Bringing the Whole Gospel to the Whole Man

## CONCEPTUAL FRAMEWORK

**Takeo AOG Churches ↔ The Assoc. of Widows in God's Hands ↔ Volunteers & Funding Partners**

- A closely-knit mutually interdependent relationship based on common shared principles and philosophies of ministry, working together as a Team (Christ's Family Development Team - CFDT) to help achieve a common goal.

### Khmer Family Enrichment Program (KFEP)

- **Integrated Small Farm Development Projects (ISFDP)**—Family-based food production projects using feasible integrated farming methods, teamwork and mutual reciprocity.
- **Food For Work Plus Projects**—Family-based Pond-digging projects through Sweat Equity, and teamwork.
- **New Life Development Centers** – A multi-purpose facility to be used as Village Pre-school, training center for livelihood skills, health and literacy classes, and a place for the local church to meet.
- **New Life Hatchery and Fish Farm** – Our main demo site for integrated fish farming approaches and also an income-generating project to help raise local funding for the Association. This is also the training ground for more aquaculture technicians needed to extend our projects to other communities. Also a job-creation project for the needed hands in the Hatchery.

### Khmer Youth Development Program (KYDP)

- **KYDP Vocational Training Center** – Offering affordable technical skills education for the youths, starting from language and computer courses, soon to include other skills-related vocations that are highly sought after by the communities. Having been initiated and carried out by the young people themselves, this project has also provided job opportunities for some of them and at the same time help raise local funds for the Association.
- **Young Life Development Center** – Residential facilities for High School students from far away villages, which also give them opportunities to learn integrated farming approaches by actually doing it themselves in the Center. The students will also have a chance to earn something from the produce of their demo farms. This also opens job opportunities as staff are needed to mentor the students

### The Cambodian Volunteer Brigade
